The team they put together to deliver a fantastic event is an achievement that the Club is most proud of.

Treasurer's Report

Over the past 12 months the club has continued to be profitable.

Total income, without allowance for grant income, increased approximately 67% when compared to the previous year. This was primarily brought about by a significant increase in Sponsorship with the Support A Knight initiative, and Special Events/Carnival income via T20 World Cup and u17 National Championships.

During the last season the Club also undertook a major fundraising event for the McGrath Foundation. This event was very well supported and successfully raised \$25,553 which in turn was donated to the Foundation. This would not have occurred without the tireless efforts of the organizing committee, volunteers and community support by way of donations.

Accordingly, expenses for the last period increased by 22%. Both the income and expenditure totals include funds raised and donated to the McGrath Foundation. Overall, the end result was a profit of \$52,207, which is an excellent outcome.

In September 2022 the Club received a \$60,000 grant from Cricket Tasmania in support of a second turf wicket. The Board is continuing discussions and negotiations with interested parties on this matter.

The club remains in a strong financial position. We will continue to consider further investment of member funds in the facilities where appropriate.

The club's current financial position could not be achieved without the efforts of all our loyal and hardworking volunteers. We look forward to another successful season.

Second Grade Captains Report

The 2022/23 second grade season was a special one with what was anticipated to be a difficult task to maintain the lofty standards of past seasons. With a wealth of experience moving on from the club, our side was made up of 6 different players to start the season that won the Premiership the season before. The ever-changing nature of the team dynamics was present throughout the season with more than 20 players used and 3 captains leading the team through an almost perfect season.

There were many highlights throughout the season given the challenges the team faced. The team went through the entire season unbeaten besides the last roster game where we were 1 wicket away from being outrighted the week before finals. Our semi-final was against the opposing team from the week before and we had two 17 year olds in Zac Curtain and James Scott stand up and give us a glimpse into the future of our great club. When the opposition were 1/105 at lunch, James Scott came to the crease with the ball in hand and changed the game taking 5/48 (18.3) to bowl New Town out for 168. In the chase it was Zac Curtain who scored a mature 112 (240) to anchor our chasing innings and stave off any chance of defeat at the hands of New Towns strong bowling line up. In the grand final against the old enemy, Clarence we were set 293 to win after an extremely long day in the field. Josh Henley was the pick of the bowlers, 3/68. (25) and James Scott also bowled well taking 3/73. (21) Whilst there were strong contributions with the bat, Josh Henley, (68) Liam Perryman, (31) Jaryd Van Der Steege (36*) the man of the match honours went to retiring club legend Jason Shelton. A masterful innings filled with experience and patience can't be described in any higher regard. Shelts finished 121* (235) and guided his team, one final time, to victory and the premiership.

A huge thank you to all of our coaching staff, board of directors, volunteers and match day officials as we cannot take the field without you.
